



## **Disaster Preparedness Checklist**

DISASTER KIT	IDEALLY ENOUGH TO COVER UP TO TWO WEEKS, BUT AT LEAST ENOUGH TO COVER THREE DAYS' WORTH
Water	One gallon per person per day; additional water should be stored in larger containers for food preparation and sanitation purposes
Food	Non-perishable (canned food, dried fruits, nuts)
Batteries	Plan for 72 hours of power outage; 24-pack of AA/AAA batteries; 4-pack of C batteries; 12-pack of D-cell batteries; enough 9-volt batteries to refill all smoke detectors in your house
Flashlights/Lanterns/ Headlamps	Battery-powered
Radio	Battery-powered
Chargers	Cell phone; laptop; consider a solar charger
First-Aid Kit	Pre-made or customized; include medications you or your family needs; copies of prescriptions, medical cards, doctors' contact information and consent forms for dependents
Gasoline	If you own a generator
Camp Stove	And fuel
Pet Supplies	Food, comfort items, medications, kennels, leashes/collars/harnesses
Personal Hygiene Items	Toothbrush/toothpaste, deodorant, baby wipes, hand santizer, sunscreen, insect repellent, feminine products
Multi-Tool	Includes a knife, screwdriver, can opener, scissors, etc.
Cooking Utensils	Spatula, spoons/forks, knives, tongs, cutting board
Waterproof matches

	Cooking Supplies	Pots and pans; plates/bowls/cups
	Change of clothes and shoes	Warm, comfortable clothing and sneakers
	Tent/sleeping bags/ pillows/blankets	If you have to sleep outside of your house
	Heavy duty plastic bags	Garbage bags and Ziploc bags
	Protective gear	Goggles, dust masks, work gloves
	Fire Extinguisher	
	Toilet Paper	
	Copies of Personal Documents	Insurance policies, home inventory, medical records, birth certificates, drivers licenses, visas (if applicable); stored in a waterproof, portable container and/or electronically
	Emergency cash	Also, traveler's checks
	Whistle	To signal for help
	Spare eyeglasses or contact lenses with solution

	Infant/Children's Items	Formula, diapers, bottles, books, games, comfort items
	Paper and pencil
